APPLICATION FOR SEWER AND WATER LATERAL CONNECTIONS AND AGREEMENT

The undersigned owner, or authorized agent of the owner of the following property, at site:

_____ hereby makes an application for Village utility laterals as follows:

_____ inch water service lateral, _____ inch sanitary sewer service lateral _____ inch storm sewer service lateral
Installer must verify that all laterals **are clear** and functioning **prior** to making connection to them.

All new and replacement sanitary sewer laterals shall be installed with an approved **backwater check valve**.

Storm sewer laterals are designed for sump pump discharge only, **not** for residential drains or down spouts.

All non-metallic laterals shall be installed with a **tracer** wire per Dept. of Commerce and Village utility regulations

All installations must use Wis. Dept. of Commerce and Little Chute Utility Dept. **approved materials and methods**.

Notice: Any work performed in the public **right-of-way** shall require record of surety on file in the amount of \$10,000 with the Dept. of Public Works indemnifying and holding harmless the Village of Little Chute for any suit or claim by reason of the excavation or construction prior to commencing of excavation within any right-of-way. This permit is conditioned upon the applicant restoring the right-of-way to a condition similar to that prior to the construction insofar as possible, by filling, leveling, replacing concrete curbs, pavements, walks and drives, any obstruction may be upon the right-of-way. All such restoration is to be completed within 60 days of disturbance and no later than November 1st without prior permission of public works department. This permit is further conditioned upon careful maintenance of the public safety by the permit holder and is subject to revocation at any time by reason of failure to maintain barricades, warnings, or other safeguards, as required by the Director of Public Works or their designee.

All locates or maps of utility locations must be obtained through the Department of Public Works at: 108 W Main St., or by phone at (920) 423-3865

Note: The Village collects a Heart of the Valley Metropolitan Sewerage District sanitary service connection fee for all new services. The sewerage district's required connection fee is based upon the size of the water meter to be installed and is due and payable to the Village utility upon application for new service before the meter is installed.

Further, the owner is hereby notified; when the water is turned on, the owner agrees to use and pay for such water service in conformity with all rules and regulations on file with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin or the office of the Little Chute Water Department, and as same may hereafter be amended.
